How does it work?

Return...

1. Pack up your empty franking ink cartridges in our FREEPOST TMR Return & Save bag and pop it in the post, remembering to include your company details so we know who you are.

It's simple, when you buy inks from TMR, we include a **biodegradable return bag** (it's yellow, but green...) with every order sent out from our head office — which amounts to thousands annually.

2. Receive 5% OFF your replacement franking ink cartridge cost, on top of any existing TMR discounts or offers.

To help reduce the environmental impact and minimise the carbon footprint on deliveries, we recommend you **send back more than one** empty cartridge at a time. So, if you send 5 franking cartridges back, you'll get 5% off the equivalent number of replacement inks when you call **0800 977 8098** to order. i.e. 5 with 5% discount each.

Even if you didn't buy your ink from TMR... call us on 0800 977 8098 and we'll send you a Return & Save bag to make sure you can recycle your waste cartridges and save.

Meeting plastic recycling targets

Why is all this important for meeting plastic recycling targets? Well if you dispose of empty ink cartridges through the general waste system, many local authorities do not recycle plastics other than bottles, so cartridges could be sent to landfill sites, where it can take years and years for them to decompose. Landfill can also contaminate surrounding soil and water, as well as emitting harmful methane and carbon monoxide. Another waste management alternative widely used, incineration, is considered the most toxic for humans and releases greenhouse gases into the atmosphere. So the only sustainable option is waste prevention, which is the avenue we are following.

Working with our **fully-compliant recycling partners**, we aim to reduce, reuse and recycle the plastic cartridges used in our franking machines and address labellers. Once our empty ink cartridges are received, they will be examined and tested in their specialist laboratory, so that they can be treated and processed correctly and restored to their original condition, for subsequent refilling and reuse, or broken down for recycling. This promotes waste prevention in our environmental chain and reduces the impact of energy used in new production.
